

1. Get Started 1.1 Assembly

Connecting the Handlebar:

- Connect the two plugs from the Handlebar and Stem Tube. Tuck any excess wire into the Stem Tube.
- Slide the Handlebar into the Stem Tube.
- Tighten using the four screws. Make sure the screws are tight and the Handlebar is secure.



1.2 Battery Care Tips

- Only use the included charger.
- Plug the charger into the wall before the Charging Port.
- Don't turn on the Element while it's charging.
- Charge the battery until it is fully charged up to 4 hours.
- Replace the cover over the Charging Port when done.

1.3 Unfolding the SCOOTER




Unclip the hook from the Rear Foot Brake.

Lift Handlebars away from Deck.



Lock the Release Lever by lifting it up until it clicks.



Make sure the Release Lever and Handlebars are secure. Unlock the Release Lever to fold.

1.4 Operating the SCOOTER



- Powering On Press the Power Button to turn on.
- Powering Off Hold the Power Button for 2 seconds to turn off.
- Speedometer Hold the Power Button for 6 seconds to wrable to suitoh.
- Speed Modes Press the Power Button once to switch the speed modes.
- **Light Function** Press the Power Button twice to turn on the headlight. The light symbol will show on the LCD Display.

2. Make Moves

2.1 Riding the SCOOTER

- Place one foot in front.
- Place the other foot in back, at a 70-90° angle.
- Turn the handlebar to the left or right to make turns.

2.2 Using the Thumb Throttle



Note: Use the throttle gently until you get used to it.

2.3 Using the No-Ebvake

Note: Press down on the E-Brake slowly to avoid stopping abrupt or losing control.



Care & Maintenance

RIDING RANGE

The maximum range is 16 miles. However, many factors will affect how far you can go per charge:

- Driving Surface: A smooth, flat surface will increase driving distance.
- · Weight: More weight means less distance,
- Temperature: Ride, charge, and store the Element above 50°F.
- · Maintenance: Timely battery charging will increase driving distance.
- Speed and Driving Style: Frequent starting and stopping will reduce driving distance.

CLEANING THE SCOOTER

To clean the scooter, carefully wipe with a damp cloth, then dry with a dry cloth. Do not use water to clean the scooter, as the electrical and electronic systems may get wet, resulting in personal injury or malfunction of the scooter,

- · Keep away from fire and excessive heat.
- Avoid intense physical shock, severe vibration, or impact.
- · Protect from water or moisture.
- Do not disassemble the Element or its battery.
- . If there are any issues with the battery, please contact Jetson Customer Support.

- Fully charge the battery before storing. The battery should be fully charged once a month after this.
- · Cover the Element to protect against dust.
- Store the Element indoors, in a dry place.

- Avoid riding around flammable gas, steam, liquid, or dust that could cause fire.
- Never operate the products barefooted and keep shoelaces tied.
